


## **Meeting Venue**

#### Location

The meeting will take place at the Center for Security Studies (KEMEA) (Λεωφ. Μεσογείων 96, Αθήνα 11527) (96, Mesogeion avenue, Athens 11527). Please bear in mind that in order to enter the KEMEA premises you need to show your ID/passport and provide your full name and job title. Once you have entered from the central gate in the front, please follow the signs to find the conference room.





If you may have any specific accessibility needs or additional questions about reaching the venue, feel free to contact the event organizers in advance.



#### 1. Getting There by Metro

Athens currently has three main metro lines (Line 1 – Green, Line 2 – Red, and Line 3 – Blue. KEMEA is closest to Line 3 (Blue Line).

- 1. <u>Nearest Metro Station</u>: **Katechaki Station** (Line 3 Blue) This station is about a 5-10 minute walk from KEMEA.
- 2. From Syntagma Square (City Center) to Katehaki:

Take the Blue Line (Line 3) in the direction of Doukissis Plakentias / Airport. Get off at Katehaki Station (approximately 6 stops from Syntagma, ~10 minutes). Exit the station following the signs to Katehaki Avenue or Kifisias Avenue.

#### 2. Walking Directions from Katehaki Metro Station

- 1. Exit the station and look for signs toward **Katechaki Avenue** or the **Ministry for Citizen Protection**.
- 2. Walk east along Katehaki Avenue for a few minutes.
- 3. Turn onto P. Kanellopoulou Street; KEMEA will be located at No. 4 on your right-hand side.
- 4. You can also use Google Maps walking directions for a more precise route.

#### 3. Getting There by Bus

Main Bus Lines Near Katechaki Station: Several bus lines stop around Katehaki Avenue. From Syntagma Square or other central areas, you may find direct or single-transfer routes leading to the Katehaki area.

1. **Bus Tickets**: You can use a paper ticket for both metro and bus. Ensure you validate your ticket once on board the bus or at the station entrance for the metro.

#### 4. Getting There by Taxi / Ride-Share

- Taxi: Taxis are readily available throughout Athens. You can hail a taxi on the street, go to a designated taxi stand, or use your hotel concierge to call one.
- Ride-Share Apps: Beat or Uber
- Approximate Costs:

From Syntagma Square to KEMEA: ~10–15 EUR (depending on traffic).

From Athens International Airport: ~35–45 EUR (flat daytime rate to downtown Athens).



## Hotel recommendations

Below is a curated list of hotels that are relatively close to KEMEA, most within a couple of kilometers. The nearest metro station is Katehaki (Line 3 – Blue), so you can easily reach the venue on foot.

## How to get from the airport

• From Athens International Airport (Eleftherios Venizelos):

The **Blue Line (Line 3)** directly connects the airport to the city center.

Board the metro at Airport Station heading toward Dimotiko Theatro (Piraeus).

\* Airport metros run every 30 minutes Travel Time: Approximately 40 minutes to the city center

Ticket Type	Price	Includes Airport	Duration
Metro Airport Single	€9	Yes (one way on Metro 3)	One journey
Airport Bus Single	€6	Yes (only that bus route- Syntagma-Airport)	One journey
3-Day Tourist (Airport)	€22	Yes (2 airport trips total+Unlimited rides on all other public transport in Athens)	72 hours
24h "All Day"	€4.10	No	24 hours
Standard 90-Minute	€1.40	No	90 minutes (all modes except airport)

- Tickets & Validation: Athens public transport uses integrated tickets (metro/bus/tram). Time-based tickets (90 minutes, 24 hours, 5 days) are valid across all modes. Always validate your ticket/card to avoid fines.
- Schedules: Metro trains generally run:

Monday-Thursday & Sunday: ~5:30 AM until midnight.
