- *Research, Intelligence, and Technology for Heritage and Market Security*
- **Duration:** from October 2022 until September 2025, 36 months, ENDED.
- **Main objectives:** RITHMS aimed to broaden and update the overall understanding of the **phenomenon of illicit trafficking in cultural goods** and develop a **digital platform** to support LEAs in identifying criminal networks and gathering **accurate and efficient intelligence** to prompt future investigations.
- **Relevant outcomes:**
 - 1 SNA-based, AI-powered, interoperable platform capable of collecting OSINT data (50 scrapers), merging them with police data in a comprehensive knowledge graph, performing network analysis, operating link-prediction, and providing new intelligence.
 - 2 Training Workshops and 1 Training Manual for LEAs.
 - 14 Scientific Publications.
 - 9 OA Datasets.
 - 20 Key Exploitable Results (10 technical, 2 social, 8 research KERs).
